The LOS ANGELES TIMES, a daily newspaper of Los Angeles, California, lists RUBEN SALAZAR as its Mexico City Bureau Chief.



OLAS was formed in January 1966 by delegates from many Latin American countries meeting in Havana, Cuba. At its First Conference in Havana in August 1967, it announced its goals as the promotion of guerrilla warfare and revolution in Latin America; support of the Negro "revolution" in the United States; and creation of a continent-wide organization with its seat in Havana.

Articles appearing in the LOS ANGELES TIMES indicate that SALAZAR covered the OLAS Conference.

The files of the Passport Office, United States Department of State, reviewed by a representative of the Federal Bureau of Investigation on October 23, 1967, disclose that Ruben Salazar was issued Passport Number F253220 on May 11, 1965, at Los Angeles, California, for a six-week trip to the Dominican Republic, to report on that country. In his application, dated May 11, 1965, at Los Angeles, he indicated that he planned to leave from Miami, Florida, on or about May 11, 1965, via air. This passport was valid for three years' travel to all countries except Albania, Cuba, and those portions of China, Korea and Vietnam under communist control.

He stated that he was born on March 3, 1928, at Juarez, Mexico, and immigrated to the United States in February, 1929. He had lived continuously in the United States, since that date, at El Paso, Texas; San Francisco and Los Angeles, California. He was naturalized on November 27, 1953, at the "Federal Court", El Paso, Texas, and was issued Certificate of Naturalization Number 7120572. The file reflects that this certificate was seen and returned to him by the passport authorities. He gave his permanent residence as 16049 East Amber Valley Drive, Whittier, California. His parents were listed as Salvador Salazar, born at Gudalejara, Mexico, February 21, 1898, and Luz Chávez, born at Monterey, Mexico, February 16, 1910. He was last married on May 15, 1959, to Sally Kobare, who was born at Los Angeles, California, on January 13, 1933. He requested that his wife, at the above address, be notified in the event of death or accident.

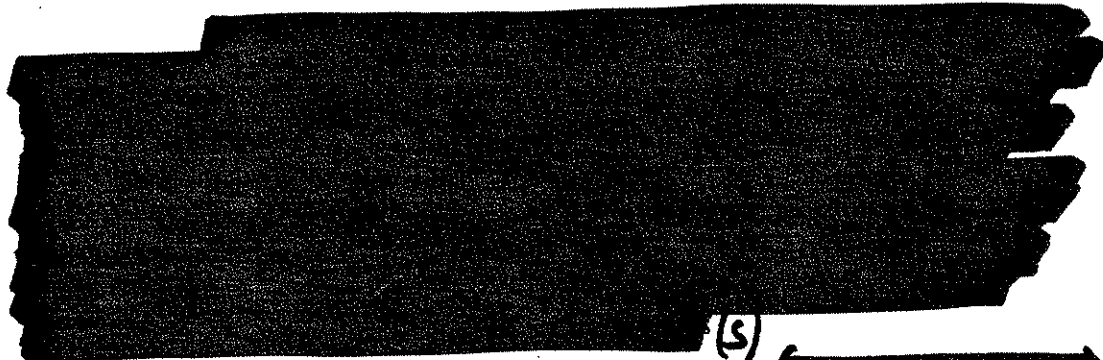

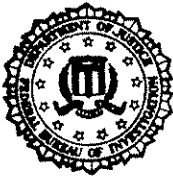

On November 19, 1968, a representative of the Adjudication Branch, Passport Office, United States Department of State, made available a file containing the following information:

On June 26, 1968, the American Embassy, Mexico City, was advised by the Passport Office that the Los Angeles Times Bureau had requested authorization for their Mexican correspondent, Ruben Salazar, to visit Cuba, beginning July 15, 1968. The Embassy was authorized to validate his passport for one round trip to Cuba.

On September 6, 1968, the above Embassy was again authorized to validate the subject's passport, Number F253220, for one round trip to Cuba.

The file contained no further details concerning either of the above validation requests.

This document contains neither recommendations nor conclusions of the FBI. It is the property of the FBI and is loaned to your agency; it and its contents are not to be distributed outside your agency.

On the night of August 31, 1970, a meeting was held at the Marcus B. Armijo Recreation Center on El Paso's south side, which was attended by about 50 to 75 Mexican Americans, including youths and adults. Representatives of the following organizations were present at the meeting:

GI Forum, a national organization made up primarily of Mexican American adults involved in the solution of problems facing the Mexican American people;

Mexican American Youth Association (MAYA), an activist organization on El Paso's south side which has concerned itself with problems of poor Mexican Americans in El Paso;

Mexican American Political Association (MAPA), a Mexican American student group at the University of Texas at El Paso (UTEP) concerned about problems of Mexican American students;

Movimiento Estudiantil Chicano de Aztlan (Chicano Student Movement of Aztlan) (MECHA), an activist Mexican American student group on the UTEP campus.

Such prominent Mexican Americans in the community as Dr. Raymond Gardea, local physician, Mr. Paul Moreno, Texas State Legislator, and Mr. Hector Bencomo, Southside Businessman, were present at the meeting.

The meeting was held for the purpose of considering the action to be taken by the Mexican American people in El Paso as a result of the fatal wounding of Mr. Ruben Salazar in Los Angeles, California, on August 29, 1970, at the time of the disturbances in that city. Mr. Salazar was serving as a Reporter for the Los Angeles Times at the time of his death. He had grown up in El Paso, had attended UTEP, and was highly regarded by the Mexican American people in the community.

It was agreed by those persons in attendance at the meeting that a memorial service would be held for Mr. Salazar on September 12, 1970, possibly at St. Patrick's Cathedral in El Paso, where Mr. Salazar had been a member when he resided in El Paso. It was agreed that this would be a religious memorial service, and that no demonstration would be held in connection with this service. It was agreed that the parents of Mr. Salazar should be contacted in El Paso to insure that the memorial service was held in accordance with their wishes.

It was also agreed at the meeting that a protest rally would be held at Liberty Hall in El Paso on September 16, 1970, by the interested Mexican American groups for the purpose of protesting the killing of Mr. Ruben Salazar in Los Angeles. In addition, a discussion was held at the meeting regarding the disproportionate number of Mexican Americans who had been killed in Vietnam, and it was agreed that the protest rally on September 16, would include protests regarding this matter.

The plans for the September 12 and September 16 affairs were not finalized at the meeting. Mr. Felipe Peralta, Director of the Minority Mobilization Program VISTA Group in El Paso, who represented MAPA at the meeting,

and Mr. Cruz Chavira, an instructor of the National VISTA Group in El Paso, agreed to organize the September 12 and September 16 affairs. The members of the MAYA organization, led by its President, Gerardo Araujo, and Abelardo Pichardo, also agreed to take part in organizing these affairs.

It was stated at the meeting that the MAPA group would prepare leaflets and have them distributed throughout the community, inviting all Mexican Americans to take part in these two affairs. In addition, it was agreed that paid advertisements would be included in the El Paso newspapers announcing these two activities.

Representatives of the Amalgamated Clothing Workers of America, including its President, Mr. Tony Pena, were present at the meeting, and made available Liberty Hall for the use of the protest rally on September 16, 1970. The Labor Union had already reserved Liberty Hall for that date, it being noted that September 16, 1970, has been celebrated by Mexican Americans in El Paso during the past few years because of the fact that it is an Independence Day in Mexico. The Union members indicated that the Union would give full support to the September 12 and September 16 affairs.

It was also agreed at the meeting that a short demonstration and march would be held from an undetermined point in El Paso to Liberty Hall on the night of September 16, 1970, immediately prior to the protest rally.

At this point, no violence is anticipated in connection with the September 12 and September 16 affairs. The feeling of the Mexican American people in regard to the death of Ruben Salazar is very strong. However, no movement is known to be afoot at this time to resort to any violence or unlawful activity regarding the matters expressed herein.

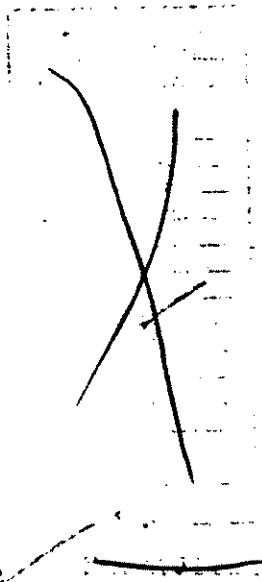

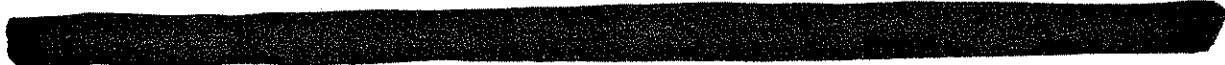
