Source stated further that property damage in the riot area amounted to an estimated \$400,000, and that 173 buildings had been burned or damaged, 7 buildings being completely burned. Twenty-five LACSO vehicles were damaged and one was destroyed by fire.

As of 12:00 noon, August 30, 1970, source further advised the trouble area was quiet, and no additional incidents had occurred. The source stated that a canvas of informants reflected no future plans known to date. LAPD and LACSO still remain on complete tactical alert.

LA T-5 advised that as of 9:00 PM, on August 30, 1970, the troubled area was still relatively quiet. There were a few instances of small groups gathering, but they dispersed without incident. There have been one or two isolated instances of objects thrown at patrol cars, and one arrest has been made; however, details of arrest were not available at that time. The source added that no information had been developed concerning plans of the protesters. He added that an absence of out-of-state cars possibly indicated these people have departed the city.

The parade started around 11:00 AM, and proceeded to Laguna Park. Source observed a large number of Chicano youth gangs between the ages of 15 to 16 years, consuming large quantities of beer and wine. The aroma of marijuana was also strongly prevalent in the area of the groups. Source noted at the time, the temperature was in the mid-nineties, and the combination of these circumstances appeared to be one of the causative factors in the disorderly activity which followed.

Source stated that around 3:30 PM, the Chicano youth groups began taunting the LAPD and LACSO officers, and shortly thereafter, they began hurling rocks, bottles, and street debris at the officers. At this time, the groups were approximately one block from the Silver Dollar Bar on Whittier Boulevard.

Source advised that the Los Angeles Committee for the Defense of the Bill of Rights (See Appendix), is planning on issuing a leaflet on August 31, 1970, blaming the LAPD and the LACSO for causing the riot.

A source advised in May 1969 that the LACDBR has expanded its former scope of interest relating to the foreign born, and has become a militant general defense organization allegedly seeking to safeguard the rights of all individuals, including the foreign born, as well as those seeking to avoid military service in the Armed Forces of the United States.

The LACDBR is a non-membership organization which is represented by an Administrative Board of about 125 individuals from loosely organized area committees interested in the work of the LACDBR. These board members are invited by ROSE CHERNIN, Executive Director of the LACDBR, who is the guiding, dominant, and motivating force behind the LACDBR. Its headquarters are maintained at 325 West Third Street, Los Angeles, California.

Another source advised in May 1969, that ROSE CHERNIN is currently Organizational Secretary of the Moranda Smith Section of the Southern California District Communist Party (SCDCP).

The Young Chicanos for Community Action, also known as Brown Berets, was formed during 1967, within the predominantly Mexican-American eastside of Los Angeles. The Young Chicanos for community Action acquired the name Brown Berets when they identified themselves as a group by wearing brown berets and Khaki Army fatigue jackets. The group has approximately 35 active members.

In 1968, DAVID SANCHEZ, Prime Minister of the Brown Berets, prepared a booklet entitled, "The Birth of a New Symbol - the Brown Beret Manual". This booklet states in part as follows: "For over 120 years, the Mexican-American has suffered at the hands of the Anglo establishment. He is discriminated against in schooling, housing, employment, and in every other phase of life. ...Because these injustices have existed and the Anglo establishment shows no sign of changing them, and because the cries of individuals have gone unheard and fallen upon deaf ears, a group of Young Chicanos have come together under the name of the Brown Berets to demand an immediate end to the injustices committed against the Mexican-American".

This manual also states that the purpose of the Brown Berets is summed up in its motto: "To Serve, Observe and Protect". According to the manual, the portion of the motto, "To Protect", means "To protect, guarantee, and secure the rights of the Mexican-American by all means necessary. How far we must go in order to protect these rights is dependent upon those in power. If those Anglos in power are willing to do this in a peaceful and orderly process, then we will be only too happy to accept this way. Otherwise, we will be forced to other alternatives".

The manual also sets forth the Ten Point Program of the Brown Berets as follows:

1. Unity of all our people regardless of age, income or political philosophy.
2. The right of bi-lingual education as guaranteed under the Treaty of Guadalupe Hidalgo.
3. We demand that the true history of the Mexican-American be taught in all schools in the five Southwest states.
4. We demand a Civilian Police Review Board made up of people who live in our community.
5. We demand that all police officers in the Mexican-American community, must live in the community and must speak Spanish.
6. To want an end to Urban Renewal Programs that replace our barrios with high rent homes for middle class people.
7. To demand a guaranteed annual income of \$5,000 for all Mexican-American families.
8. We demand that all Mexican-Americans be tried by juries consisting of only Mexican-Americans.
9. We demand that the right to vote be extended to all of our people regardless of ability to speak the English language.

10. We demand the right to keep and bear arms to defend our communities against racist police, as guaranteed under the Second Amendment of the U.S. Constitution.

Since its inception, the Brown Beret organization has concentrated mainly on protests against the Los Angeles City School System, claiming discrimination against Mexican-American students. Several members of the Brown Berets have been arrested for disruption of Los Angeles City Schools. Several have been arrested for burglary and arson.

## INFORMATIVE NOTE

Date 8-31-70

Mexican-Americans held protest in Los Angeles 8-29-70 to protest number of Mexican-Americans killed in Vietnam. Previously information was received that Brown Berets, militant organization, urged participants to arm themselves during demonstration. Crowd subsequently became disorderly, police vehicles damaged, numerous fires were started, and Ruben Salazar, correspondent for local Los Angeles newspaper and news director of Spanish language television station, was killed. Salazar reportedly was wounded in head by a tear gas projectile fired by police. Twenty-five civilians treated for minor injuries, 28 sheriff's office deputies injured, and over 150 arrests made. As of early evening 8-30-70 demonstrators were dispersed by police.

from Raynosa, Mexico. The "coyote" fees were ten million dollars (\$10,000,000.00). The Texas Transmission Co., located at Shreveport, Louisiana has entries on the books beginning in August, 1952, and continuing until April, 1956, under the name of "Special Fees" totaling this amount. This money was paid to Miaja and went from him to Antonio Bermudez, administrator of PEMEX since Aleman's administration.

In addition to these individual outrages, entire departments such as CEINSA work not as planned, for the good of the people -- in the specific case of CEINSA for the controlled distribution of basic foodstaples -- but as government controlled monopolies. On the one hand, these government monopolies have been used to force out and to limit the development of private business through individual initiative; and, on the other hand, they have permitted favorite contractors to sell these supplies, subject of course to "coyote" fees, which are offered to the public at controlled prices. Quality is typified by a pair of pants with one leg cut an inch shorter than the other.

Corruption is an erosive factor which shifts from top to bottom. In the Los Angeles Times, January 10, 1962, Ruben Salazar, from Juarez, Mexico, reported: "Policemen, teachers and city employees have complained that they are not paid for as long as 90 days at a time. Reformers claim that policemen make up for it by "mordidas" (bribes) from tourists, and point out that many teachers have been driven to part-time bartending, and city employees to driving taxis."

In Mexico, as in many other countries, the local citizen and the foreigner have come to expect quasi-official corruption as the only way of doing "business". Such customs as the "coyote" fee and "mordidas" are obviously not compatible with the spirit and purpose of the Law of Public Functionaries. Corruption as a way of life saps the vitality of a nation. Mexico, from the 20 peso bribe to the \$10,000,000 "coyote" fee, is being sucked by these parasites.

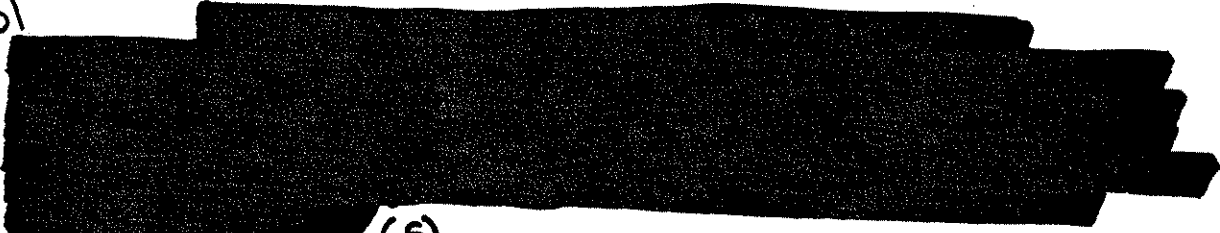

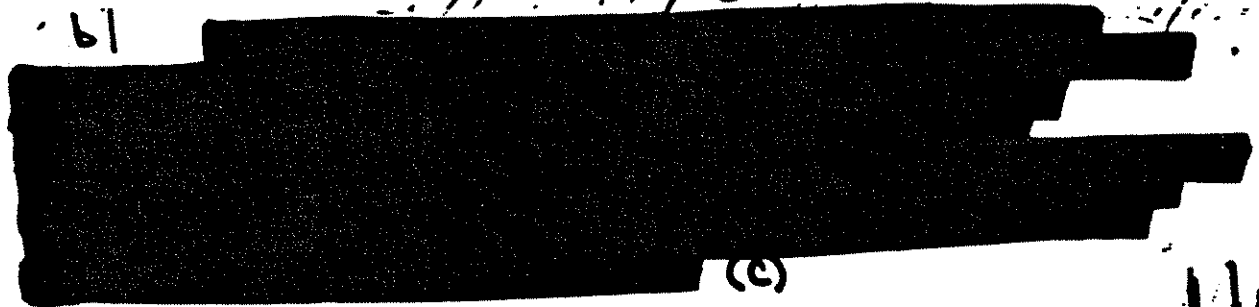

The Subject stated that he acquired fifty-one photographs in September, 1952 from [REDACTED] who took the photographs immediately after a riot at the POW compounds after General DODD was released and General BOATNER had taken over command of the island. At the time the pictures were purchased from [REDACTED] for \$5.00, [REDACTED] was assigned to the same unit as the Subject. The Subject stated that [REDACTED] is still in the Korean area assigned to the 7th M. P. Service Company, APC 59. The Subject stated that it was his recollection that the film was developed in the United States by [REDACTED] and twenty-one sets of the prints were sent to [REDACTED] who sells the sets for \$5.00 per set. The Subject stated that he knows of only two other individuals who have purchased sets of the pictures, namely [REDACTED] and RUBEN SALAZAR. The Subject stated that both of these men were recently discharged from the service, and stated that [REDACTED]'s home address is Dallas, Texas, and SALAZAR's home address is either Los Angeles or San Francisco, California.
